Log on to the Kairos of Texas - Hughes Unit web site and print the names of the team members and candidates. The site is at:

Look to the left and select the button labeled **Hughes Weekends** and click on it.

Look to the left for the current Weekend **Hughes # ??** which is generally the first one listed

Look to the left and select the **Prayer List** and then print it out the lists

If you can't access the web site, or find someone to print out the names for you, don't worry, God knows who you are praying for, and your prayers will be heard.

Thank you for your prayers, you have joined in the Spirit.



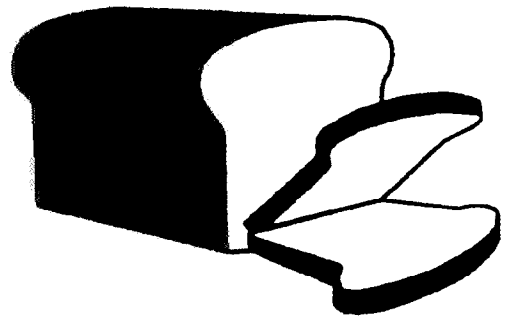
## **WRITTEN AGAPE GUIDELINES**

- PURPOSE:** To provide written encouragement, support and expression of GOD's love to the residents attending this event. (There are forty-two candidates, we will need 42 letter's per writer.)
- MATERIALS:** The same type of paper and envelopes should be used to keep each resident from feeling like the guy next to him has a more colorful letter than his. There should be NO imprinted logos, messages, or designs as part of the paper. There should be NO stickers or stamps added to the paper or the envelopes. These envelopes should be plain and unsealed. Team members are permitted to, and should, seal their letters. These letters may very well be the ONLY sealed letters that a resident will ever receive while an inmate with the TDCJ. The impact of this event alone is a powerful display of GOD's love.
- Content:** Salutations should be to "Dear brother-in-white," for non-team contributors; team members will be able to use the residents name. Since we will not know who the "final" forty-two candidates are until Friday morning, do not complete the salutation when you write your letters. Set aside the same pen that you used to write your letters, and bring it with you. You will want to add the resident's name using the same style of pen. Letters should be short, personal, and sharing of a relationship of GOD's love, and expressing encouragement to seek this love for themselves.
- Instructions:** Writer should not include addresses; team members' address will be given to the residents at a later time. It is beautiful to have children write or draw something, BUT by no means should a last name or an address be given. Pictures drawn by children are great and very acceptable.
- PLEASE:** No poems, songs, photo's, bookmarks, tracts, or printed pictures.



### KAIROS COOKIE PREPARATION INFORMATION:

Homemade cookies are a tangible expression of christian love and an indication of "God's" concern to a group of people who seldom encounter either in the course of their daily lives. YOUR loving sacrifice will provide the "BREAD" that will shine the "LIGHT" of "GOD'S GRACE" into the darkest -----of corners-----in the prison.



### COOKIE PREPARATION:

1. The types of cookies that are considered to be acceptable are: OATMEAL, PEANUT BUTTER, MOLASSES, CHOCOLATE CHIP, GINGER, SUGAR.
2. The cookies should be between 2", and 2 1/2", in diameter and not over 1/2", thick.
3. It's very important not to use any ICING, SUGAR, or any other type of COATING on the outside of the cookie's.

### PRAYING:

1. Pray individually or as a family over the ingredients before and during mixing.
2. Pray over the cookies as you drop them onto the cookie sheet and bake them.
3. Pray over them as you bag them for freezing.
4. Ask "God" to use your cookies to be a source of his love to shine on these prisoners on the weekend when "Kairos" is in the prison to be examples of how "Christ" has shown us to love each other.



We want them to become a part of the "Family of God". Pray that each cookie could bring the prisoner that eats that cookie and the bag of cookies to a relationship much closer to "GOD".

### PACKING:

1. Bag the cookies in "Zip Lock" freezer or sandwich bags, a dozen to a bag.
2. Label EACH bag with the cookie type inside.
3. After labeling, **FREEZE ALL THE BAGS OF COOKIES!**

### HANDLING: FOR KAIROS

1. Deliver cookies to one of the team members
